Introduction



Veterans Day

Veterans Day (originally known as Armistice Day) is a federal holiday in the United States observed annually on November 11, for honoring military veterans, who are people who have served in the United States Armed Forces

The Veterans Day Moment of Silence Act calls for two minutes of silence every Veterans Day to recognize and reflect on the service and sacrifice of all veterans, past and present. The set time of 2:11 PM EST allows for all 50 states and Puerto Rico to take part simultaneously.

What We Do Everyday Case Stories

Outside forces and circumstances beyond our control create issues for all of us . Add to that being a veteran suffering from PTSD and other medical conditions and it can lead into a place of hopelessness and helplessness. Such is often the case when a veteran shows up at the end of a long day; not knowing where, when, how or who to turn to for immediate needs. Recently, a veteran came to us for help getting a car out of the shop, to be able to get to doctor's appointments which have already been scheduled and changed three times, plus needing to get his medication in a timely manner. **We were able to help him with getting his car repairs paid and get him on the road. His tearful response was "Thank GOD, Veterans Outreach was able to help; was there when I needed them."**



A Florida based veteran called, crying. He was a single parent with a small daughter, and the power had just been cut off. He felt that he had let the child down, and was not the responsible parent that any child would need. **We got the particulars, contacted the utility and got the power restored – he is extremely grateful for the help provided by Veterans' Outreach.**
